A deposit of £250 per person is required to reserve the space. Credit cards are not accepted.

Final Payment: Final payment of balance is due 90 days before departure, January 12, 2012.

If you must cancel:

91 or more days before departure..... Total Program Payment refunded LESS £150 Non-Refundable Deposit.

61-90 days before departure..... Total Program Payment refunded LESS £250 Non-Refundable Deposit.

16-60 days before departure..... Total Program Payment refunded LESS any amounts needed to cover supplier costs and cancellation fees.

1-15 days before departure.....No refund

Cancellation while on tour.....If you cancel for any reason while the tour is in progress, there will be no refund for that portion of the program that you do not complete. Any expenses incurred will be the responsibility of the tour member.

Tour prices: Prices are quoted in BPS£ and based on current tariffs, rates of exchange, taxes, levies and cost as of May 2011. Should any of these costs change significantly, a surcharge may be made on the price of your trip by Nov 1, 2011. You will be notified of a change in writing sent via email or postal mail if you have no email.

Tour price includes: all ferry and coach transportation, all accommodations and breakfast, half of lunches and dinners & tips for these meals, entry fees, guide fees, the workshop, special events as listed on final itinerary.

Tour price does NOT include: Transportation to and from Scotland, transfers between airport and hotel, passport, meals & tips not specified as included, medical expenses, items of a personal nature, alcoholic beverages, room service, tips for coach driver, trip insurance, baggage insurance, laundry, phone calls, internet charges, forwarding of baggage and souvenirs.

Travelers Get to Scotland on Their Own: Travelers arrange their own transportation to and from Glasgow, Scotland. Nadine offers airline tips and information on when to book in the second trip letter, "Greenlight."

Coach: Travel is via a five-star operator who uses low emission, two year old or newer Mercedes mini-coaches at 16 passenger capacity, with big panoramic windows, efficient heating and cooling system, sound system, and full-sized seats with seatbelts. No bathroom onboard.

Itinerary: If improvements can be made, or unforeseen circumstances beyond our control make changes necessary, we reserve the right to vary itineraries and make surface transportation changes. ____ (Initial)

Accommodations: Cozy 3 and 4 star B&Bs and small 3 star hotels. Many of the rooms are ensuite. Some lodging establishments have a shared bathroom down the hall from your room. The rooms and bathrooms vary in size from tiny to spacious, even in the same establishment..____ (Initial)

Single supplement: A few single rooms are available for a £275 supplement. We make every effort to find roommates for single passengers who wish to avoid the supplement. However, we cannot guarantee success in finding roommates. We urge travelers who snore thunderously or have major disruptive sleep issues to consider a single supplement.

Smoking and Fragrances: Smoking is not allowed on the motor coach or indoors. There is no smoking in the B&B', hotels, restaurants and pubs. All travelers are asked to refrain from using products with fragrances on the trip. (No perfume, aftershave, strongly scented hair products or soaps, etc.) ____ (Initial)

Passports and Visas: Your passport should be valid for 6 months beyond trip dates and with sufficient blank visa pages. ____ (Initial)

Responsibility: The Singing Weaver, Nadine Sanders, guest escorts or guides and/or affiliated or subsidiary companies are not responsible for accidents, loss, detention, annoyance, delays and expenses arising from same, quarantine, strikes, failure of trains, motor vehicles, planes or any other means of conveyance to arrive or depart as scheduled, disturbances, government restrictions or regulations, discontinuance or change in transit or hotel services and other causes over which we have no control. As the full responsibility of the operation of the vehicles used for these tours rests with the company (ies) or person engaged in conveying passengers, and said company (ies) of operation, recourse for any mishap must be sought in the country where accident occurs. Reasonable changes in the itinerary may be made where deemed advisable for the comfort and well-being of the passengers. The right is reserved to refuse to accept or retain anyone as a member of the tour at any time. The coach company is not to be held responsible for any act, omission, or event during the time the passengers are not on board the coach. The passage contract in use by the coach company, when issued, shall constitute the sole contract between the coach company and the purchaser of this tour and/or the passenger.

I understand that this is a physically active and demanding tour, meaning that I'll:

- *climb lots of stairs*
- *do a lot of standing while sightseeing*
- *may have to sit on the coach up to 6 hours in a day*
- *will be required to rise before 6:00 am on several travel days*
- *will carry my own bag to my room up and down one to four flights of stairs that may be uneven and twisting*
- *will carry my own bag to and from the coach to and from my lodging which may entail walking up and down hills, on gravel, grass, carpet, cobblestones, and pavement*
- *walk an average of 2 miles per day*
- *will not be dropped off at the door step of most venues*
- *will have to walk to some group activities once coach service concludes for the day*
- *be responsible to assure I am physically prepared for the rigors of the trip*
